Q4 *Would you have been financially able to complete your degree without the financial aid you received?

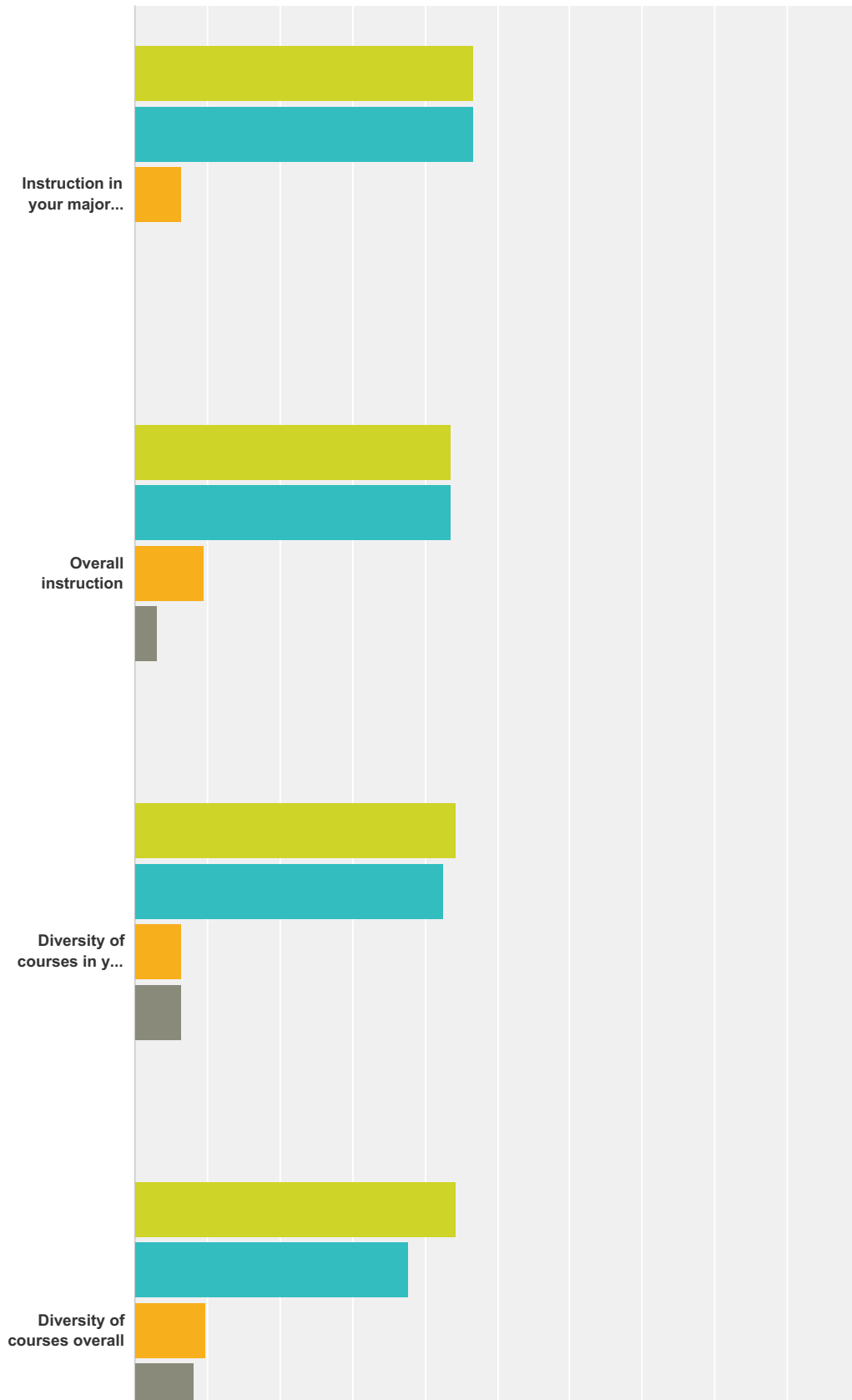

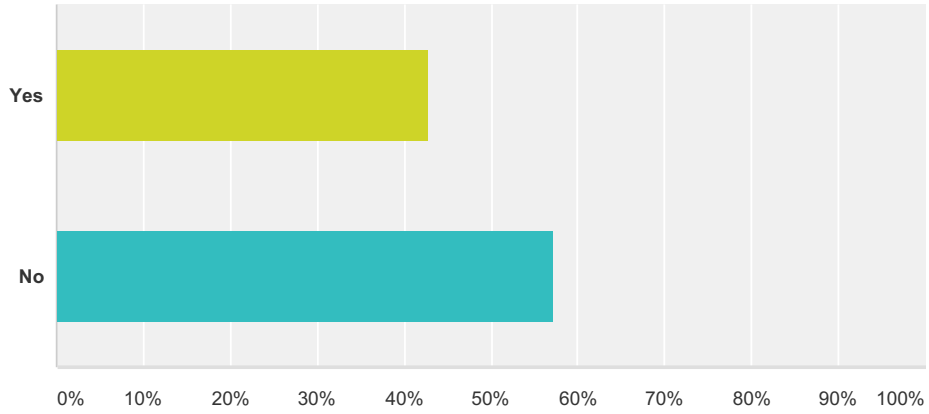

Q9 Excluding summer school or terms spent at other institutions, will you have taken more than 8 semesters (4 years) at CSU to complete your degree?

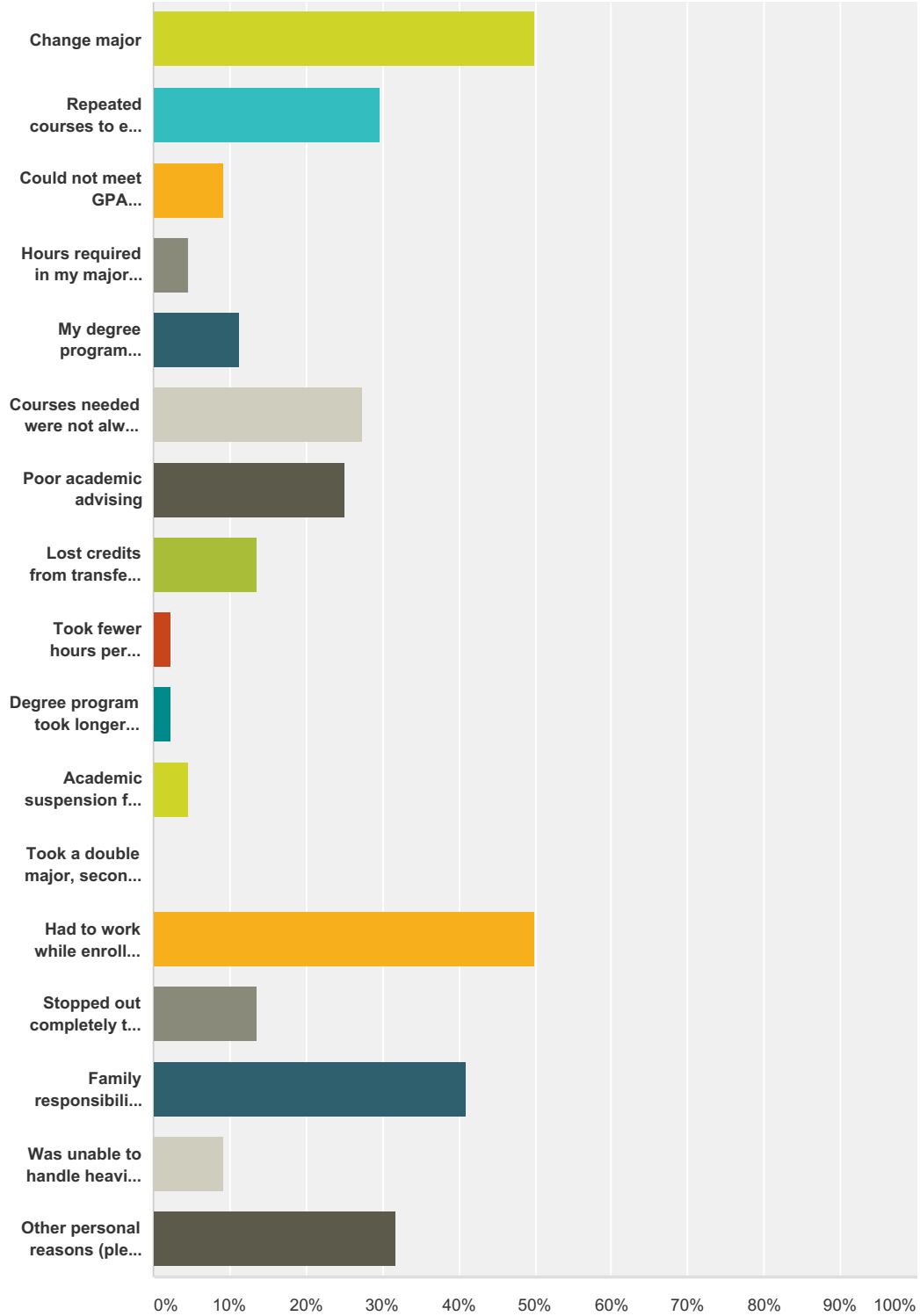

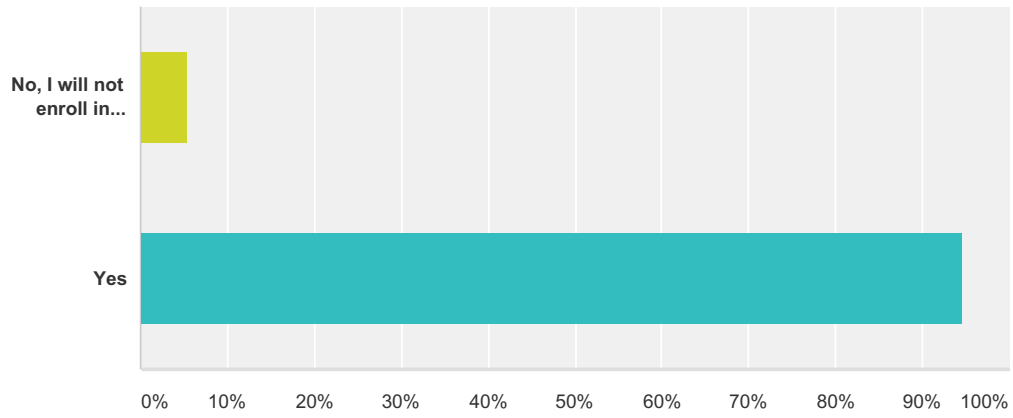

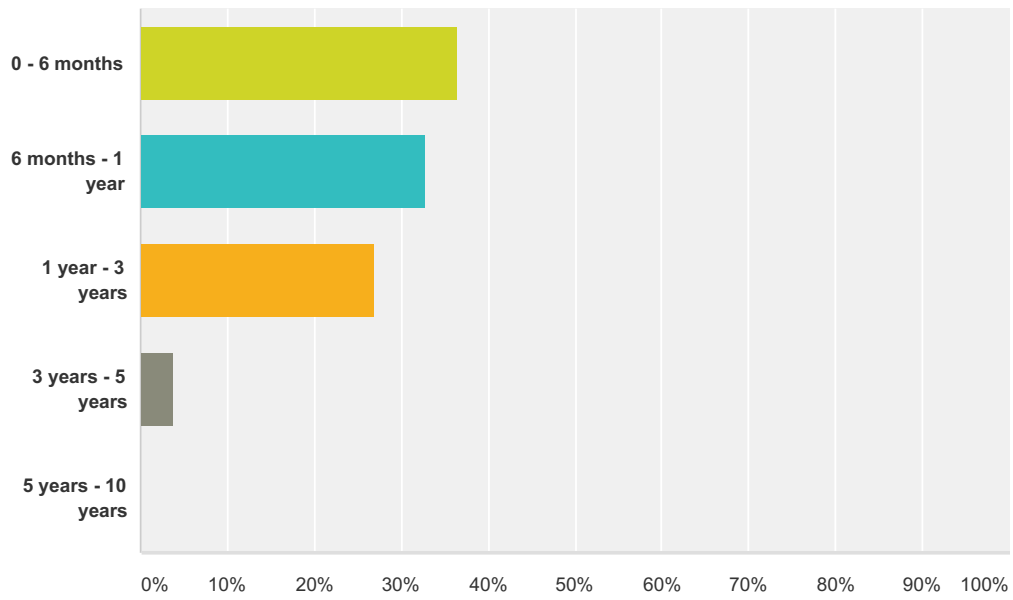

Q12 If you plan to continue your education, how soon do you plan to return?

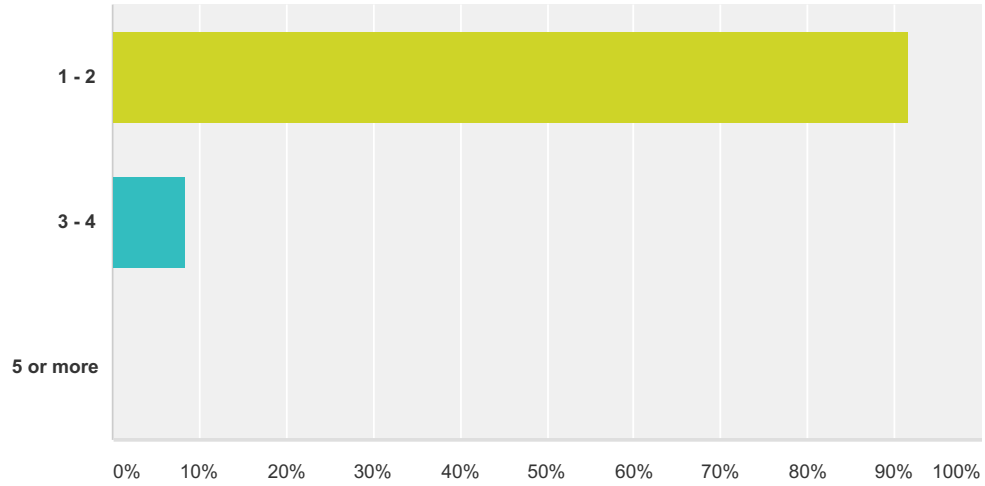

Q13 If you have applied to graduate or professional schools, please indicate the number in which you have applied?

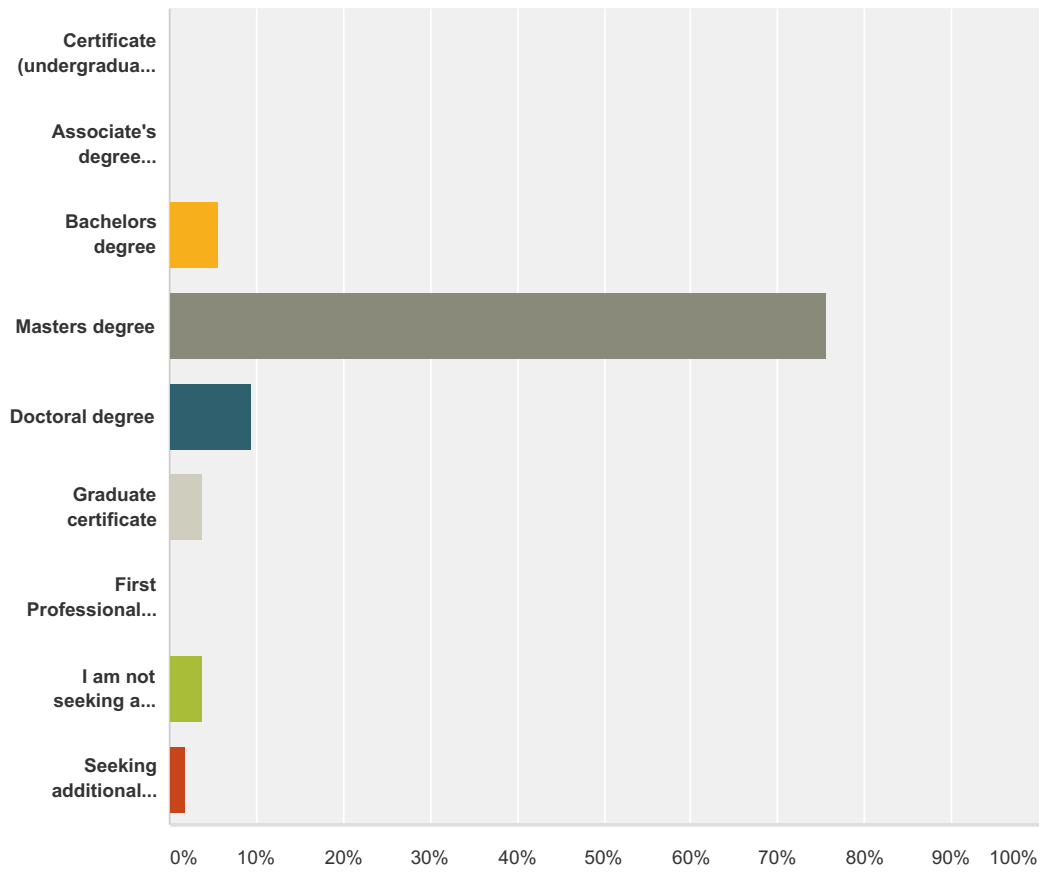

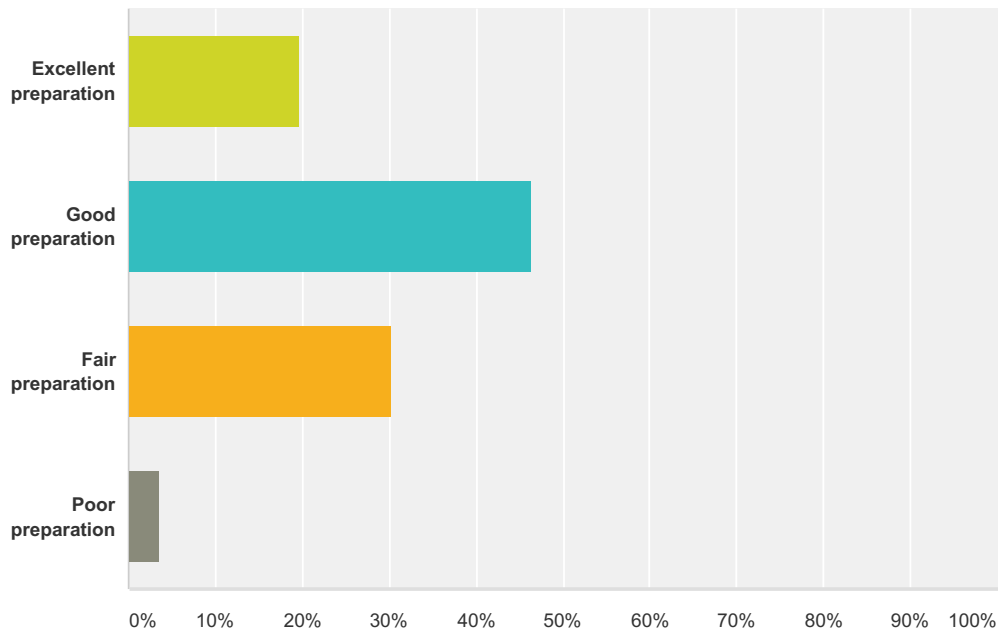

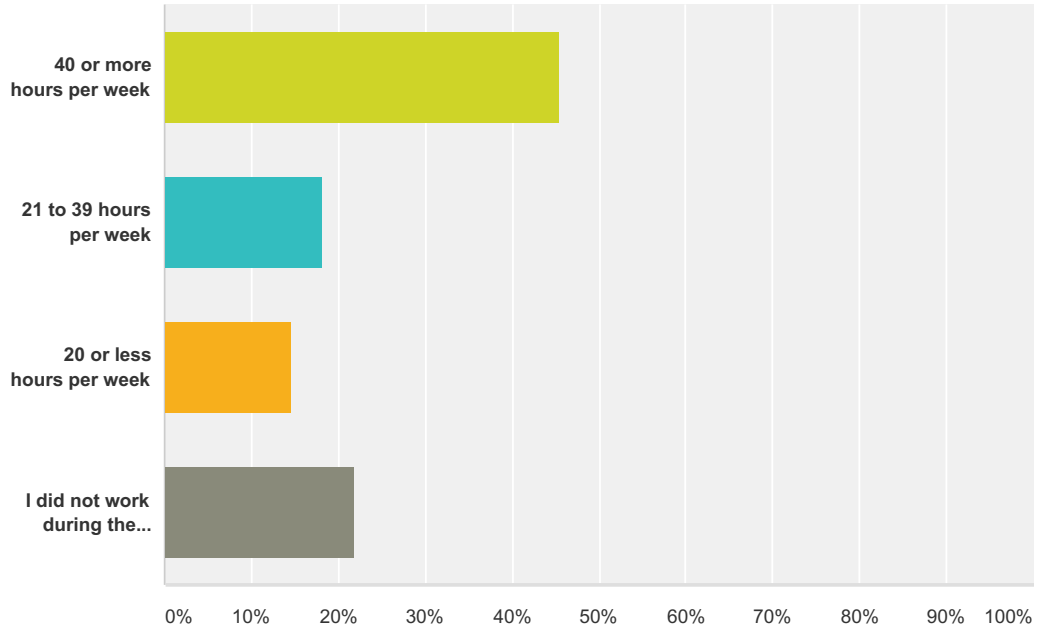

Q17 If you worked a job on or off campus during the academic year while at CSU, on average how many hours per week did you work?

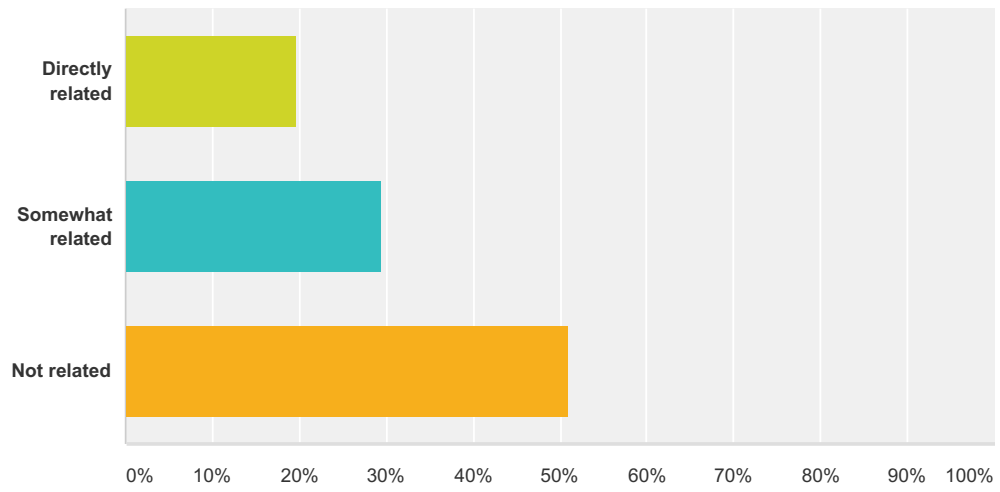

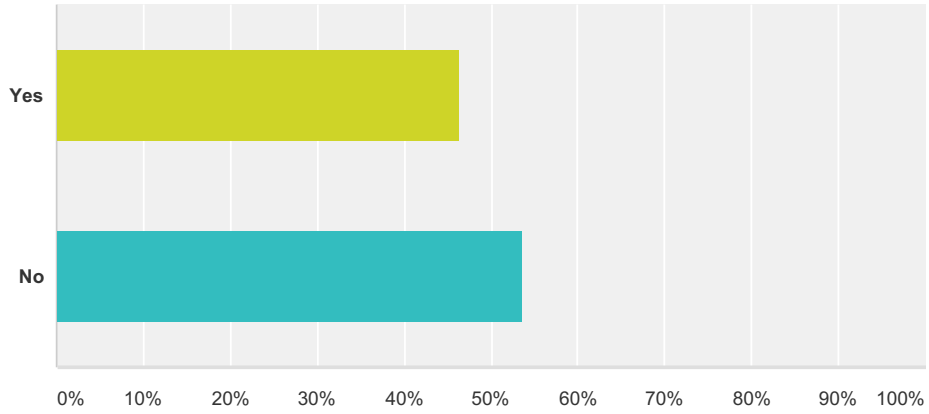

Q19 Did you participate in a Co-op (cooperative education) or internship program?

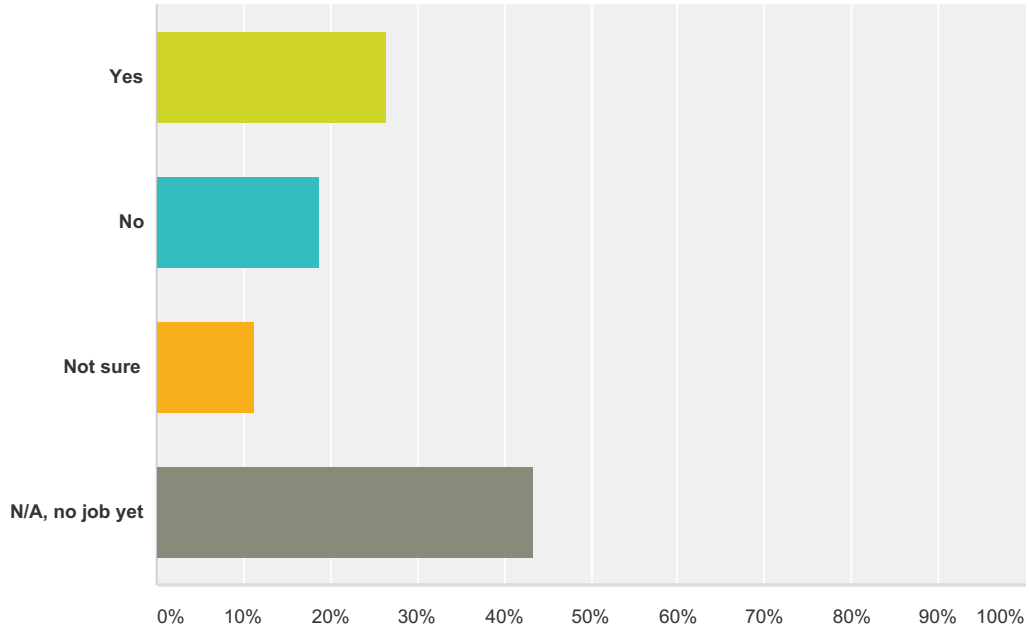

Q20 Was the Co-op experience or internship helpful in securing a position of employment?

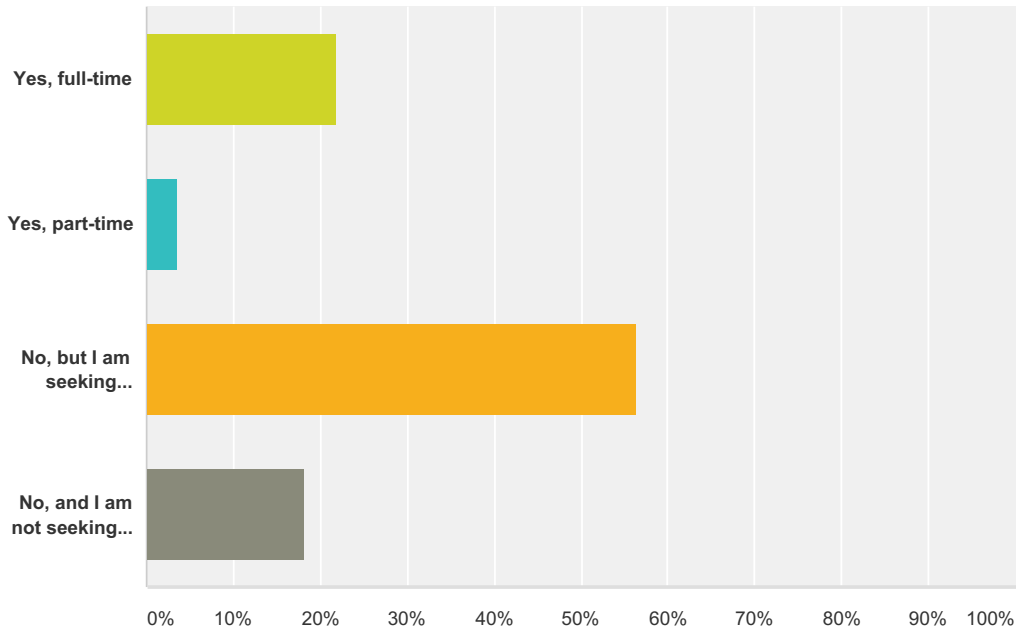

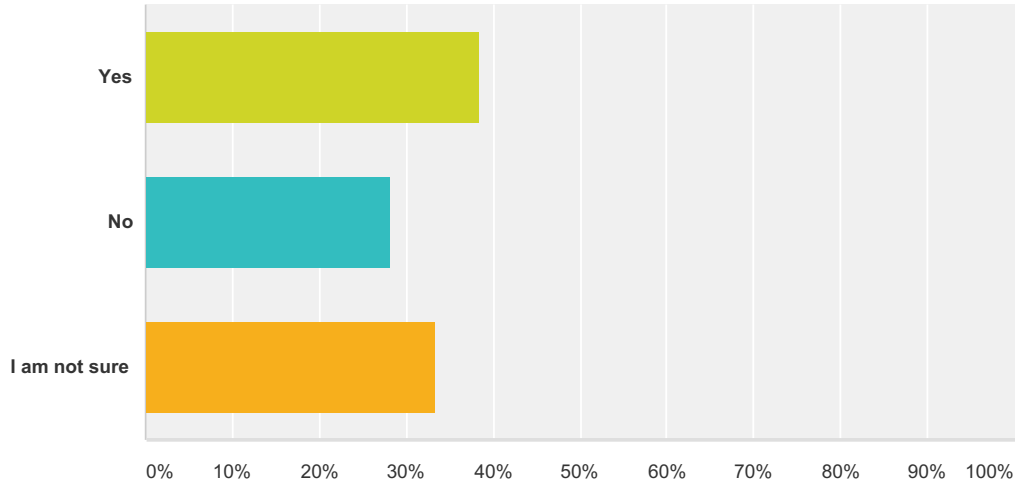

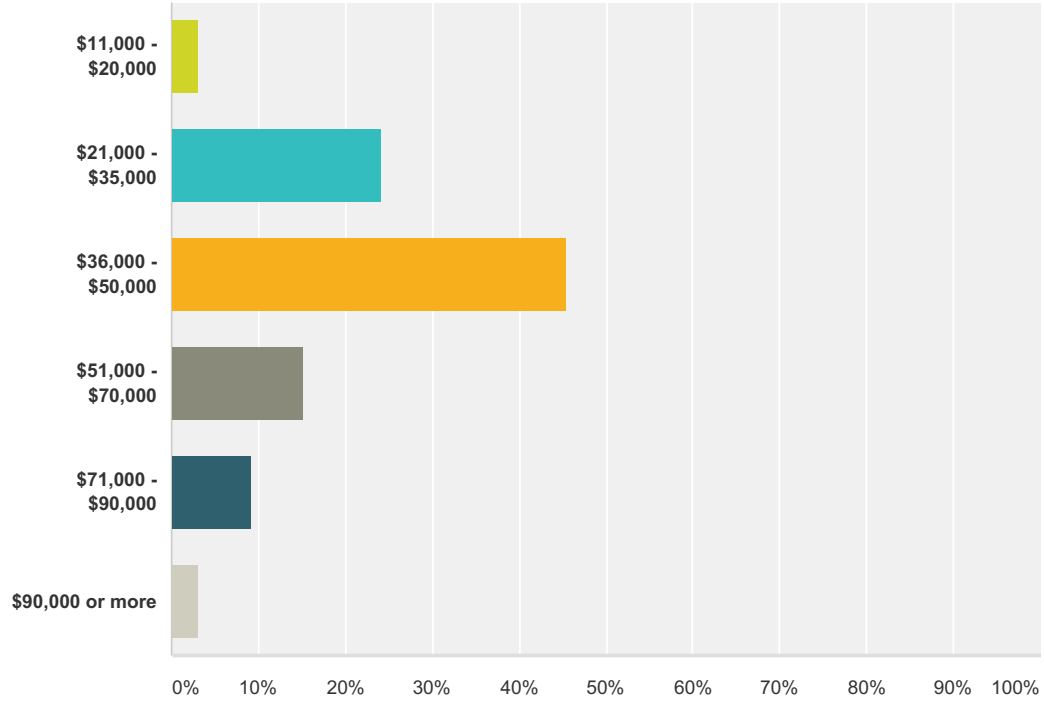

Q24 If you have accepted a full-time position of employment, within what general range will your salary be per year?

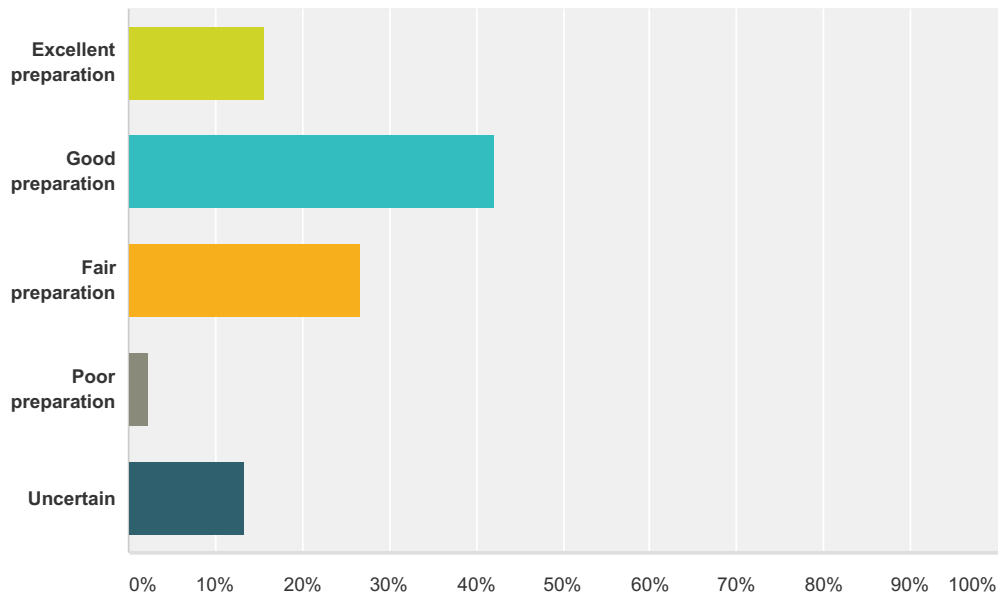

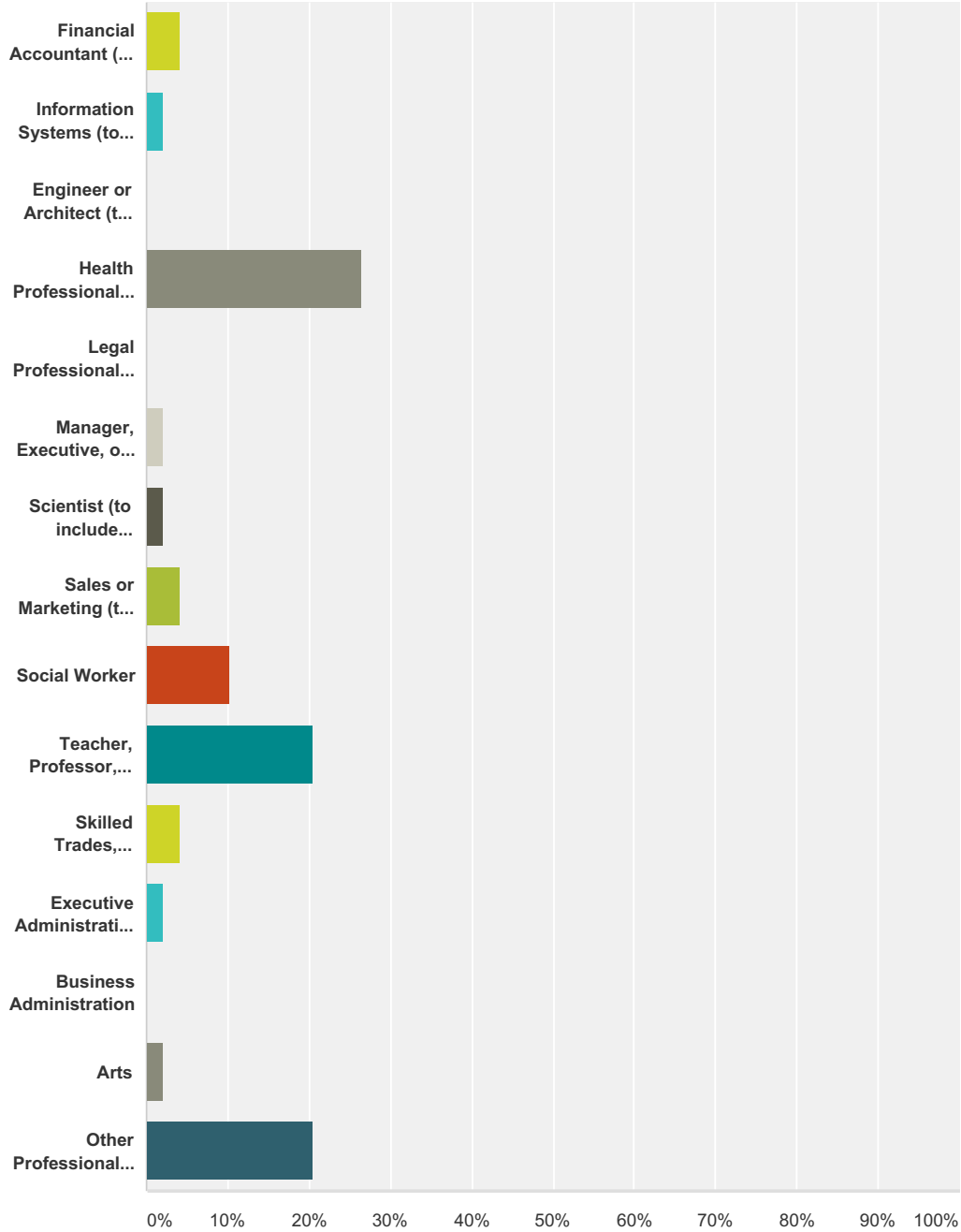

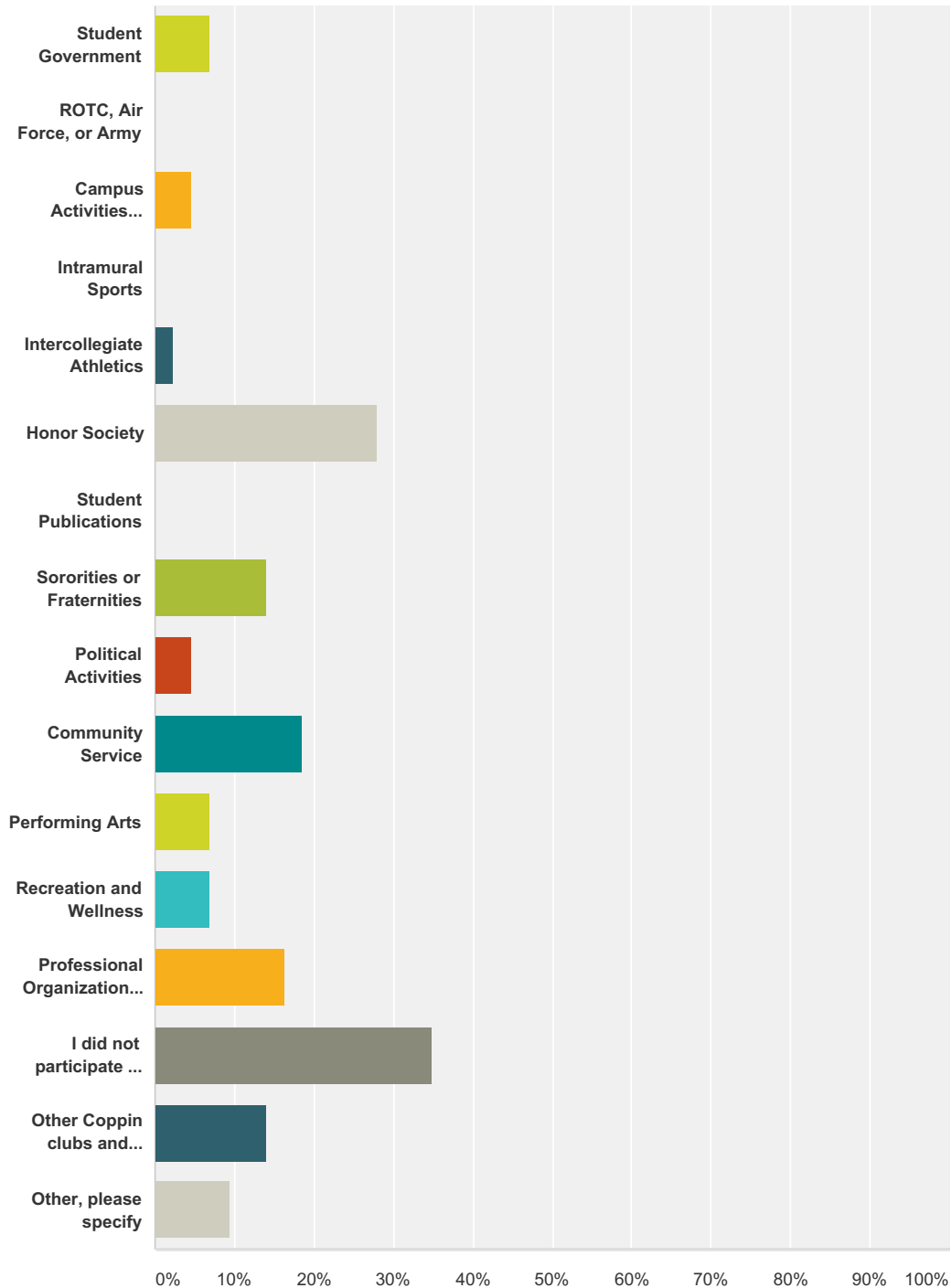
